

## The Untouchable Castro

Nixon, the Kennedy brothers, CIA, FBI, the mafia, and Cuban refugees tried like hell to kill Castro, and failed miserably time after time. Castro outsmarted them all.

There was also a plot to blame Castro for the JFK assassination. In the months leading up to Nov 22, 1963, CIA was working feverishly to establish links between Oswald and Cuba. His links to Russia had already been established. Once JFK's head was blown off, LBJ, a conspirator in the assassination and central figure (along with his good buddy J Edgar Hoover) in the coverup, had three options. So, LBJ packed the Warren Commission with men he could control and trust to do as they were told. Warren kept the Commission from investigating anything. Instead, for the most part, they simply accepted whatever the FBI fed them. J Edgar Hoover immediately shut down any investigation by the FBI, telling his men within a couple of days to wrap it up. The case was solved. No need to waste any more time. They had their man -- Lee Harvey Oswald. Just as LBJ had instructed. (Hoover's key role in the coverup was made much easier with Gerald Ford on the Warren Commission. Ford secretly let Hoover know everything that went on at the commission. Any attempt at real investigation work was quickly nipped in the bud by Warren and Hoover. Just as LBJ had ordered.)

Castro was visibly shaken when he learned of JFK's death. The Kennedys had established secret back-channel negotiations with the Cuban dictator, and it seemed to be promising. Castro knew he was likely to be blamed for the murder. What he didn't know is that parallel to the secret negotiations, the Kennedy boys were also plotting to kill Castro. If the secret talks failed, plan B was a Castro assassination.
